Avril Macdonald

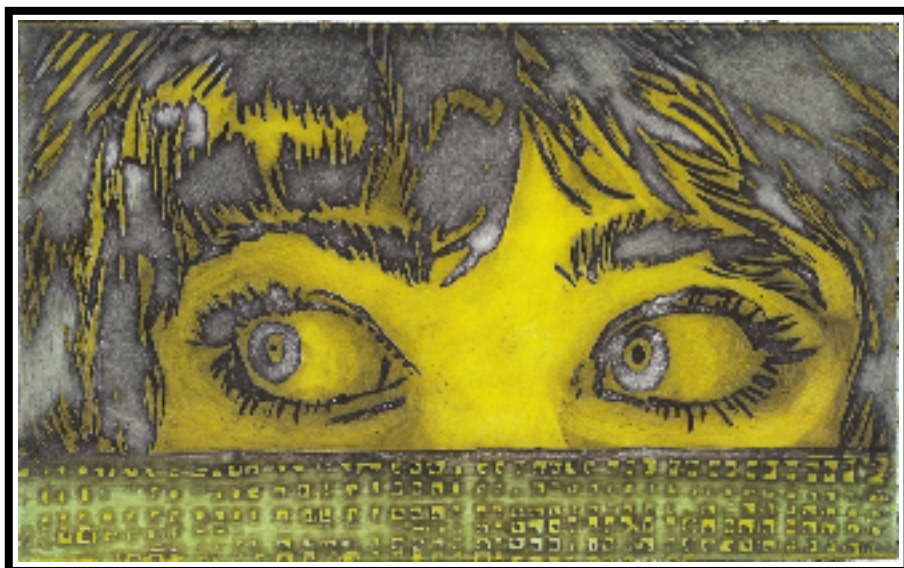
Avril Macdonald trained as a textile designer at the Scottish College of Textiles and De Montford University before becoming a music journalist, newspaper editor and PR consultant.
