Through its annual open exhibition opportunities, Orleans House Gallery in Twickenham helps artists both locally and nationally to showcase their work in group exhibitions. ## **RULES OF ENTRY FOR BOTH EXHIBITIONS**

- ∞ Any media (prints, photos, paintings, objects, sculptures, film) and style are considered. However, please note that **we are unable to show films at the Riverside Gallery**.
- ∞ Artists can submit up to 5 original works, which must be submitted as high resolution jpeg files on a CD, with accompanying A4 size photographic prints or colour printouts. Do not send original work.
- ∞ Clearly label each submission with: artist's name, title of work, date, media, approximate size and price before commission if the work is for sale (the gallery adds 40% of the artist price for commission + VAT).
- ∞ In addition, please enclose contact details (email and postal addresses and contact telephone numbers) an artist's statement and CV.
- ∞ There is a £10.00 administration charge (which also contributes towards exhibition costs); £7.50 concessions (please include proof). Please make cheques payable to L.B.R.U.T. Your submission will not be accepted without payment.
- ∞ If you would like images returned, please enclose a stamped self-addressed envelope.

Successful artists will be contacted by email or in writing approximately two weeks after the deadline.
